

Production Control – Shipping Ticket Pick List

The shipping ticket Pick List option allows you to add shipping pieces to a shipping from a list of un-shipped items. The option is available for Preload tickets, Out Process tickets and Job Site tickets. The pick list can be used for any shipping ticket prior to shipment. Once shipped, the 'pick list' option is not available. Any posted items on the shipping ticket will be un-posted when the 'Use Pick List' option is selected.

You will be prompted to enter or select the drawings to make available in the pick list. If the job uses sequences, you will also be prompted to enter or select the sequences to include.
